MU-PLEVEN HOSTED THE FIFTH EDITION OF 'DAY OF BIOETHICS'

For the fifth consecutive time Medical University - Pleven hosted the unique for our country scientific event "Day of Bioethics". It was first launched in 2014 at the initiative of Prof. Dr. Silvia Yankulovska, PhD, Dean of the Faculty of Public Health.

This year's Day of Bioethics was under the motto "Ethics and Medical Technologies" and was held on 19 April in Ambroise Pare Hall of the University's Telecommunications Center. Prof. Kenneth Goodman, founder and Director of the Institute of Bioethics at the Miller Medical School, part of the University of Miami, who is also among the founders of the North American Center for Ethics and Health Information Technologies as well as the Bioethics Network Manager in Florida, was the esteemed guest-lecturer at the Science Forum. Among the previous important guest-lecturers at the event are: Professor Hancock T. Chave (Doctor Honoris Causa of MU-Pleven, University of Pittsburgh, USA), Prof. Luciana Cainaco (Padua University, Italy), Prof. Renzo Pethoraro (Papal Academy of Life and Donation) Lane for Bioethical Counseling, Padova) and Dr. Els Makelberg (University of Groningen, The Netherlands).

The well-paced organization of the scientific forum allowed the intensive program to be implemented within one day. All who professionally deal with bioethics, students, PhD students and specialists from various medical specialties, academics and the general public had the opportunity to listen to Professor Goodman's lectures as well as the reports of the other presenters - Assoc. Prof. Diana Pendicheva, 3rd-year Specialty of Medicine student, Ashraf Darvis and Chief Assistant Professor, Atanas Anov. The audience was challenged by the topics of the impact of cultural values on informed consent, the ethics of using placebo in experiments and heath practice, and the ethical dimensions of bioprinting.

The participants showed excellent knowledge of the language, Bulgarian



Children from the Children's Clinic at the University Hospital "Dr. Georgi Stranski", Pleven can now enjoy the new hospital acquisition - children's musical playground for outdoor play, donation of a social project "Margaritka" (Daisy) and the national initiative "Tales without End".

The official opening of the children's musical playground at "Dr. Georgi Stranski" University Hospital - Pleven was on 16 May at 1 pm. Together with the Executive Director of the



hospital, Assoc. Prof. Tsvetan Lukanov, the band was cut by the representatives of the social project "Margaritka" and the national initiative "Tales without End".

The musical steps and the luminous, rocking bench are innovative facilities specially developed for the common cause of the two charities and are the first of their kind in Bulgaria. They will bring joy and smiles to the children, treated at the University Hospital "Dr. Georgi Stranski" - Pleven.

Besides the charitable project of "Margaritka" and "Tales without End" initiatives, another donation was received by the Children's Clinic at June 1, 2018. The donation was courtesy of the ladies at Lions Club, who provided funds for the interior refurbishing of the clinic. Two families – Anita Hinkova and Genadi Todorov as well as Ilyian Yonchev and his wife – Dr. Yoana Ivanova also participated by donating various medical equipment for the neonatology and intensive care sectors of the Clinic.

MU-PLEVEN HAS STARTED TO ACCEPT THE APPLICATION DOCUMENTS OF STUDENT CANDIDATES AIMING FOR A SPOT IN 'MEDICINE' AND 'PHARMACY' DEGREES

From June 14, 2018, the admission of applications of students for the regular examinations for the Master's and Bachelor's degrees at MU-Pleven has officially begun. Candidate students have three options for submission of papers for examination and for participation in the ranking electronically, through the University's website; locally, by visiting room 106 at the Rectorate building or in one of the specially designated locations all over the country.

The Medical University of Pleven offers training for a total of 513 students in 14 specialties, 4 Master's and 10

Bachelor's programs in 5 professional fields - medicine, pharmacy, health care, public health and social activities.

For the first time in its history, Medical University - Pleven (MU-Pleven) has held 'on-location' examinations for its Bachelor degrees. The candidate students had the opportunity to take a biology test for the Bachelor's degrees and Professional Bachelor's degrees in the towns of Montana and Vidin, allowing for unparalleled ease of access to the examination process.

MU-PLEVEN HOSTED THE SECOND INTERNATIONAL HIFU CONFERENCE

The Minister of Education and Science of the Republic of Bulgaria, Mr. Krassimir Valchev was an official guest at the opening of the Second International HIFU Conference on June 8, 2018 in Pleven. The aim of the forum was to make a final report on the results of the bilateral research project, "Exploring the Possibilities of HIFU Technology for Treatment of Minor Diseases in Bulgarian and Chinese Patients as a Non-Invasive Alternative to the Surgical Method." The project is funded by the Ministry of Science and Technology of the People's Republic of China and the Science Fund at the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Bulgaria. Project partners are Medical University - Pleven, the HIFU Center at the University Hospital "Sveta Marina", Pleven and Second Associated Hospital at the Medical University, Chongqing, China.

During the conference, the team of the HIFU Center at the University Hospital "Sveta Marina" - Pleven, with Prof. Dr. Dobromir Dimitrov, Deputy Dean of the Faculty of Medicine, presented the 5 years of experience in the application of the non-invasive medical therapy which leads to ablation (melting) of a neoplasm through a directed ultrasound wave with unique precision. Assoc. Prof. Dimitrov shared with the attendees of the HIFU conference the results of treating over 500 cases of benign and malignant solid tumors. The therapy is organ-preserving without conventional surgical intervention - without incisions, without blood loss, with minimal risk of infection and lack of operational stress. In HIFU centers with extensive experience around the world, the risk of complications for the patient is reduced to less than 0.5%.







500 PATIENTS HAVE BEEN TREATED WITH FOCUSED ULTRASOUND SURGERY AT THE HIFU CENTER, PLEVEN

A total of 500 patients have been treated with focused ultrasound surgery (a noninvasive technology) at HIFU Center "Sveta Marina", Pleven for a 5-year period - from the end of 2012. This is the official data, summarized by the team of Assoc. Prof. Dr. Dobromir Dimitrov, Medical Manager of the HIFU Center and Deputy Dean of the Faculty of Medicine at MU-Pleven. Of all patients with benign growths, 394 were diagnosed with uterine fibroids, 26 with breast fibroids

and female genital diseases. 50 patients with pancreatic cancer were treated (in combination with chemotherapy), 7 with liver malignancies, 5 with kidney cancer, 5 with breast cancer, and 5 with soft-tissue sarcomas. During these years, at the HIFU center, Pleven, patients from over 14 countries such as Germany, Greece, Poland, Canada, USA, Italy, Romania, Spain and others were treated.

Focused ultrasound surgery is a revolutionary, radically new approach to the treatment of neoplasms in the human body (tumors) - both benign and malignant. The acronym HIFU is most commonly used, deriving its meaning from "High Intensity Focused Ultrasound" in English. This is a completely non-

invasive medical therapy in which ablation (melting) of the neoplasm is achieved by a directed ultrasonic wave with unique precision. Therapy is fundamentally health-conserving, without the need of a conventional surgical intervention - without incisions, without blood loss, with minimal risk of infection and lack of operational stress.

The HIFU center at UMHAT "Sveta Marina" -Pleven was opened in December 2012 and today it has a team of five highly qualified physicians, specializing in the work with the two HIFU machines, the IC model for ablation of solid lesions in various areas of the human body and the CZF apparatus for non-invasive treatment of surface lesions of external female genitalia. Members of the HIFU Center team have produced and published 7 scientific articles in reputable international magazines. They are also partners in three international projects, with reports made at more than 10 international scientific forums, some of which in Germany, Hungary, China, Spain, Italy, Taiwan and others. In addition, HIFU members have participated in more than 20 national congresses and conferences on surgery, oncology, imaging as well as various student forums. Three dissertation theses in the field of HIFU treatment are currently being developed.

THE CITY OF PLEVEN TOOK PART IN THE NATIONAL HEALTH CAMPAIGN, FOCUSED AROUND THE WORLD HYPERTENSION DAY

The World Hypertension Day - May 17, was celebrated for the 12th time in 11 cities in the country with a national health campaign. The initiative was initiated by the Bulgarian League of Hypertension in partnership with the Bulgarian Red Cross, the National Heart for Heart Network, the Association of Medical Students in Bulgaria, Microlife Bulgaria and others.

Three gathering points were organized in Pleven - at the entrance of Kailuka Park, Skobelev Park and in the city center. At those points, students from the Medical University - Pleven measured the blood pressure of patients with Microlife

medical equipment, which has Afib technology, which takes into account the presence of atrial fibrillation (the most common type of arrhythmia which increases the risk of strokes and heart attacks).

Within the framework of the campaign, consultations and free examinations of patients by highly-qualified cardiologists were organized in the reception room of the Clinic of Cardiology on 17 and 18 May.

PLEVEN'S MULTIPROFILE HOSPITAL FOR SPECIALIZED TREATMENT, DR. GEORGI STRAKSI, CELEBRATED THE INTERNATIONAL NURSING DAY

With a practical forum for health care professionals, UMHAT 'Dr. Georgi Stranski' - Pleven celebrated May 12 - the International Day of Nursing. The day was defined as such in 1935 by the International Nursing Committee, but began to be celebrated in 1965 in all countries. May 12 marks the birthday of Florence Nightingale, considered the founder of modern nursing and one of the 100 most influential women of all time.

The forum in UMHAT-Pleven was under the motto "International Day of Nursing - Caring for You".

The main topic of the information session was "Assisted Reproduction in Bulgaria - Past, Present and Future". The program included presentations reflecting the important events in the history of Bulgarian reproductive medicine as well as the latest trends in its development, the advanced methods and achievements in the diagnostics and treatment of infertility.



A PREVENTIVE CARDIOLOGY AND REHABILITATION SCIENTIFIC FORUM WAS HELD



The National Conference on Preventive Cardiology and Rehabilitation took place in Pleven from May 11th to May 13th. Organizer of the event was Prof. Dr. Snezhana Tisheva, PhD, Head of the Clinic of Cardiology at "Dr. Georgi Stranski" University Hospital. The initial idea of the event came from the Society of Cardiologists in Bulgaria.

During the forum, topics related to the early detection of high blood pressure, the influence of diabetes on the heart, early control and management of patients with cardiovascular diseases and their rehabilitation were discussed.

The forum in Pleven gathered leading experts from the country to discuss early diagnosis of risk factors. "Our goal is to focus people's attention on a particular condition that has long been neglected – 'familial hypercholesterolemia'", said Prof. Tishiva.

A SCREENING PROGRAM FOR EARLY DIAGNOSTICS OF REMMATOLOGICAL DISEASES HAS BEEN IMPLEMENTED IN PLEVEN

Between 18 May and 18 June, a Screening Program for Rheumatologic Diseases designed for people of working age, where early diagnosis is essential, took place in Pleven. Pleven is the second of seven cities in the country where the program is being implemented. Within a time-frame of one month, all willing citizens Pleven, aged 18 to 50, could register for a free examination.



FREE NEUROLOGICAL EXAMINATIONS WERE AVAILABLE AT THE CLINIC OF NEUROLOGY AT UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL DR. GEORGI STRANSKI, PLEVEN

Until June 25, 2018, the Clinic of Neurology at the University Hospital "Dr. Georgi Stranski" organized free examinations for people of active age. Patients over 50 years of age with an increased risk of cerebrovascular accident had the opportunity to undergo a comprehensive study

including a targeted neurological history of current complaints (headache, dizziness, decreased ability to concentrate, memory impairment, family history), blood pressure measurement and neurological examination detection of discrete neurological symptoms.

PROF. SILVIA YANKULOVSKA SHARED HER EXPERIENCE OF THE ERASMUS+ PROGRAM schedules to Erasmus+ mobility and differences in the legal

Prof. Yankulovska: "From 22nd to 28th April 2018, I had the chance to visit Bratislava not only as a tourist but also a lecturer, welcomed with enthusiasm and incredible respect by the staff of the Institute of Social Medicine and Medical Ethics of the largest university in Slovakia, Comenius University.

The preparation for this teaching exchange within the framework of the Erasmus + program started more than a year earlier, when I applied for participation and I chose the desired institution. Contact was established with the host country and the contact person provided me with a summary of the training courses and curriculum content, respectively, to identify my own fields of expertise and to offer relevant topics for lectures and seminars.

I was later delighted to see my lectures and seminars included in the official curriculum of the students' courses, which was announced on the Institute's information board.

My work program started with a meeting with the staff of the Institute of Social Medicine and Medical Ethics. During the entirety of my stay, I exchanged information about my work commitments, my qualification, the contingent of students from foreign countries, the practices of admission in Medicine, the requirements for completing the courses in Social Medicine and Medical Ethics.

I was also personally accepted by EIM Vice-Rector, Professor Ostarnikova, with whom we discussed difficulties in accrediting university degrees, adapting student schedules to Erasmus+ mobility and differences in the legal framework for the development of academic staff in Slovakia and in Bulgaria. Ideas surfaced for the development of scientific and educational projects within the framework of the Erasmus + program, in which MU-Pleven still has no experience, but Komenius University has already successfully completed a similar project.

This was my first Erasmus+ teaching opportunity, but my positive experiences make me more optimistic that I will be able to do this in other academic institutions and thus enrich my life and professional experience."

THE FIRST OF ITS KIND PRACTICAL TRAINING COURSE IN FETAL MEDICINE WAS HELD AT UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL 'ST. MARINA', PLEVEN

For the first time in Bulgaria, the Fetal Medicine Foundation, through the employ and help of three certified specialists from the Association of Maternal and Fetal Medicine, held a training and practical course on fetal morphology for obstetricians and gynecologists in the high-tech facilities of the University Hospital "St. Marina" - Pleven. The lecturers are specialists in fetal medicine in Bulgaria, trained at the Royal College of London, students and followers of Prof. Nicolaides, the pioneer of fetal medicine and Doctor Honoris Causa at Medical University - Pleven. The audience of the seminar included 27 specialists in obstetrics and gynecology, working at University Hospital "St. Marina" - Pleven and "Dr. Georgi Stranski" University Hospital - Pleven. One of them will have the opportunity to be sent to a specialization in fetal morphology under the leadership of Prof. Kipros Nikolaidis at the Royal College in London.

The participants in the seminar are the first Bulgarian obstetrician-gynecologists who have obtained a certificate of

completion of a training course in fetal morphology at the Royal College in London, signed by the father of fetal medicine Prof. Kipros Nikolaidis.







THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE ACADEMIC LEADERSHIP OF MU-PLEVEN WAS HELD ON 26 APRIL 2018

At the General Assembly of the Medical University - Pleven, on 26 April 2018 in the Magnum Hall of the Second Clinical Base, The Rector of MU-Pleven, Prof. Dr. Slavcho Tomov presented a report on the Academic Management of the Higher School for the first year of the second 4-year term of the current general







management. The General Assembly of the academic community is held once every year and is lead by its Chairman, Assoc. Prof. Ivan Lalev, Head of the Postgraduate Training Center at MU-Pleven. The Assembly includes a total of 188 delegates, of whom the largest quota is dedicated for tenured members - 132 Professors and Associate Professors, as well as 23 Assistant Professors, 28 PhD and Master's students and 5 representatives of the administration. Prof. Slavcho Tomov highlighted the

Prof. Slavcho Tomov highlighted the impressive results achieved in all major fields of activity of the University education, research, European integration and international cooperation, as well as economic and financial activities.

The Rector did not fail to mention the fact that by decision of the Government of October 4, 2017, "St. Marina" - Pleven acquired a University Hospital status, expanding the clinical base for research and training of students and postgraduates while providing them access to state-of-the-art equipment. For the purpose of training, the Virtual Room of the Telecommunications Endoscopic Center is now equipped with the new generation virtual training machines to help specialists and students master practical skills in minimally invasive surgery.

As for the students themselves, it was further noted that of the international students admitted in February 2018, for



the first time the largest number come from Italy - 123, followed by Great Britain - 75, India - 51, Germany - 17, Japan - 9, Greece - 9, forming a colorful, multi-national community. In the field of scientific research and cooperation, the Gallery of Contracts for European and International Cooperation of the university was enriched with a Memorandum of Partnership between MU-Pleven and one of the largest medical universities in China - Chongqing Medical University, focusing specifically on research and education.

Additionally, in 2017 there was a high level of activity in the organization of international and national scientific forums at MU-Pleven. THE 'ST. ELISAVETA' IN VITRO CENTER ORGANIZED: 'METABOLIC SYNDROME WEEK'

From 18 to 22 June 2018, 'ST. ELISAVETA' reproductive center - Pleven held free consultations with a specialist endocrinologist for patients with reproductive problems (e.g. polycystic ovary syndrome and sperm parameters in men). The campaign is organized in conjunction with the increased incidence of Metabolic Syndrome (MS) in these patients. It is a combination of risk factors - high blood pressure, increased blood sugar, elevated cholesterol levels, and obesity, mainly in the trunk area (the abdomen).

Within the campaign, all eligible patients received preferential prices for investigations and procedures, such as: waist circumference, triglyceride levels, total cholesterol, blood pressure, fasting blood sugar, fasting immunereactive insulin, HOMA assessment of insulin resistance, etc.
